### Opening hours

- January–April: Tuesday–Sunday 11:00–17:00, open until 20:00 on Thursdays
- May: Tuesday–Sunday 11:00–17:00
- June–August: 10:00–17:00 every day
- September–December: Tuesday–Sunday 11:00–17:00, open until 20:00 on Thursdays

### Admission charges

- Adults: SEK 180
- Children up to 18 years: Free
- Senior discount, SEK 90 on Wednesdays from September to April
- Youth discount (19-25 years old), SEK 90 on Fridays from September to April

### Guided Tours

- June–August: Daily tours in Swedish and English. Included in admission charge. No booking required. During the rest of the year, we offer English tours on Saturdays and Sundays at 11:30
- Personal guide: Permitted – free admission for authorised guides. Please notify us in advance!

## **Book a guided tour**

- June-Aug: Daily tours included in the entrance fee. No need to book in advance.
- Own guide: Allowed, authorized guides free admission. Please book in advance!
- Book a tour (45 min, max 30 people)
- Weekdays during the day: 2500 SEK (10 people) + 130 SEK/extra/person
- Evening and weekends: 3500 SEK (10 people) + 130 SEK/extra/person
- Languages: Swedish, English
- Palace Mouse Take the children's tour of the museum at your own pace: SEK 30  
Ask for the Palace Mouse at the ticket counter.

## **Audio guide**

- Adults and children: SEK 20
- Free if you use your own smartphone
- Languages: Swedish, English, German, French, Russian, Spanish children's audio guide,  
audio description guide

## **Filming/photography**

Photography and filming for your own use is permitted (no tripods/stands).
